Kimberley Echoes is a richly varied music and visual experience. Footage of Kimberley landscape and work of artists from Art Centre partners is integrated into the production, immersing audiences in the spirit of the Kimberley.

Songs by Pigram and Atkins, arranged by this unique ensemble, are juxtaposed with new music created by the collaboration all reflecting the complexity and beauty of the Kimberley. Collaborations with local artists, experiences of traditional Joonba song and dance and touring through the provocative Kimberley landscape have all weaved their influence into this work and program.

Kimberley Echoes celebrates connection and difference – the collaboration of very diverse artists on country, across time. With such iconic advocates of Aboriginal culture, alongside the many community collaborations experienced, the process has been one of expansive two-way learning. The result is a powerful juxtaposition of style and content interwoven with heartfelt humanity.
